EAST BAY WRAPAROUND



East Bay Wraparound (Wrap) strengthens families while simultaneously treating youth participants through counseling, medication assistance, and developing other sources of community support.

OVERVIEW

East Bay Wraparound (EBW) services aim to help our youth strengthen safe and healthy relationships, develop coping strategies, and connect caregivers and youth to supportive resources in their communities. The main goal of East Bay Wrap is to promote stability in the home so youth and families are able to establish and nurture a healthy, consistent living environment. Staff uses individualized, family-driven plans of action.

The East Bay Wrap treatment team consists of a combination of staff, usually including a Care Coordinator, Behavior Specialist, Psychiatrist or Psychiatric Nurse Practitioner Youth Partner, and Parent Partner—the latter two having lived experience navigating issues and circumstances similar to those of many participants and their families. Families have access to on-call clinicians for support during crises. Services are delivered at locations in the community according to family preference.

East Bay Wrap is comprised of three programs that share a common approach and staff. The EBW Full Service Partnership San Mateo provides service to foster youth living outside of San Mateo County and referred by San Mateo County Behavioral Health and Recovery Services. Youth living outside of the county in which they are court dependents. The EBW Regional Center Program provides services to youth referred by Regional Center of the East Bay. Regional Center youth struggle with intellectual disabilities and severe emotional disorders that often exceed caregivers' resources. The EBW Full Service Partnership Alameda County provides wrap services to youth aged 8-18 who live in the county. These families have high intense needs and are not connected to Probation or Child Welfare Systems.

REFERRALS

East Bay Wrap-Full Service Partnership San Mateo referrals come through San Mateo Behavioral Health and Recovery Services. East Bay Wrap-Regional Center referrals come through individual case managers at Regional Center of the East Bay. The Alameda program is referred through ACCESS.

SERVICES

Our staff provide a comprehensive spectrum of support to participating youth and their families, which may include:

- Community based, in-home, individual family therapy
- In home behavioral support
- Case management, including linking participants and families to other supports and resources
- Psycho-education
- Integrated medication support services
- Peer/family support
- Crisis Intervention
- Intensive Care Coordination

Services are available to participants and their families 24-7, in consideration of serving youth who may have frequent crises.

PHILOSOPHY

The wraparound model involves a process rooted in collaboration with the participant and their family to develop and implement plans to address their complex needs. Successful implementation relies on building on each family's strengths and encourages them to make helpful, caring connections with the community. The wraparound process ensures that services remain focused on the needs of the participant and their family. We offer hope for improvement.

Family involvement and easy access to services are critical to East Bay Wrap program delivery, promoting within each family:

Access – staff will meet with youth/families at convenient locations and times; we will return calls promptly

Voice – each youth and family contributes their opinions, thoughts, concerns, and questions to inform all planning
